The Europe Goes Local strategic cooperation project is arriving at a new milestone. After launching the <u>European Charter on Local Youth Work</u> in 2019, the network started to build an on-line toolkit to support the implementation of the Charter. This on-line toolkit, which we will call the Changemakers Kit includes good practices, explanatory and background information, a library of useful documents and an interactive tool for self-assessment and planning future actions.
